

## **CITY CENTRE DCP EXHIBITION PERIOD CONSULTATION MECHANISMS**

The exhibition of the City Centre DCP controls relied on the following consultation mechanisms:

1. 4 week exhibition period (15 November - 13 December 2021);
2. A tailored exhibition webpage via Participate Parramatta portal inclusive of online submission form;
3. Public notices and social media;
4. Notification email to 440 contacts on the CBD Planning Framework Contact List, made up of residents and individuals; developers, landowners and consultants; businesses; institutions or advocacy groups; and community interest groups.
5. Webpage promotion via: the CBD Planning Framework and CBD Planning Proposal webpages, and temporary 'On exhibition' webpage;
6. Formal submission process; and
7. Letters to specific Public Authorities and Service Providers.

### **Targeted Stakeholder Consultation**

8. Council Officers consulted a wide range of stakeholders during the exhibition phase as summarised below. This was in addition to the email notification sent to the 440 contacts on the CBD PF contact list.

### **Public Authorities and Service Providers**

9. On 11 October 2021 (Item 17.4) Council resolved to consult with the following public authorities during the exhibition period:
  - a) NSW Department of Education
  - b) Transport for NSW
  - c) Sydney Metro West
  - d) Department of Planning and Environment – (both Planning and Environment, Energy and Science Branches)
  - e) Heritage NSW – Department of Premier and Cabinet
  - f) Aerospace agencies - Civil Aviation Safety Authority (CASA), Department of Infrastructure, Transport, Regional Development and Communication and Regional Development (DIRD)
  - g) Utility providers – Endeavour Energy and Sydney Water; and
  - h) State Emergency Service (SES)
10. The City Centre LEP submission review process required Council to undertake follow up consultations with an additional four public authorities / agencies:
  - a) School Infrastructure NSW
  - b) Environment Protection Agency
  - c) National Trust of Australia (NSW Branch)
  - d) Commonwealth Department of Agriculture, Water and the Environment.

**Adjoining Councils**

11. Adjoining Councils - Ryde, The Hills, Hornsby and Cumberland Councils - were advised of the exhibition of the City Centre DCP controls and invited to comment.

**Heritage Advisory Committee**

12. The draft Heritage controls in Section 6.6 of the Draft City Centre DCP controls were presented to the Heritage Advisory Committee on 25 November 2021.
