Following recent reports advising that the Metro West transport link is being reconsidered by the NSW Labor Government:

That City of Parramatta continue to advocate for the Metro West to proceed and that the Lord Mayor write to the State Member of Parramatta and the Transport Minister confirming this essential infrastructure is critical to deliver jobs, housing and transport within the Parramatta LGA.

That City of Parramatta continue to advocate for the future link from the Aerotropolis to Parramatta

Finally, that City of Parramatta commence advocacy for a North / South connection from the Metro North West

BACKGROUND


Sydney Metro West is an underground metro railway that will link Parramatta and Sydney CBD with communities in between.

It doubles the capacity of the overcrowded T1 Western Line.

It establishes future capacity for Sydney's fast growing west and Western Sydney Aerotropolis

The previous Liberal government had already compulsorily acquired land around these planned metro stations with approximately \$9B of funding already spent

It will be very difficult for City of Parramatta to achieve it's housing uplift and accommodate jobs growth without the metro system being completed. The previous Liberal Government had delivered on the North West Metro and commenced the Metro City and Southwest.
