Native Title Advice - Parramatta City Council - Community and Crown Land Plan of Management

Lands Advisory Services (Landsas) has reviewed Parramatta City Council's (Council) final draft Community and Crown Land Plan of Management which was provided to me on 26 September 2023.

A. Future Acts

To undertake a future act (including the adoption of a Plan of Management) on Crown land Council must comply with the future act provisions of the *Native Title Act 1993* and meet the requirements of Section 8.7 the *Crown Land Management Act 2016*. Generally, Section 24JA of the *Native Title Act 1993* allows most actions that a council would be wanting to undertake. To utilise Section 24JA the reservation must have been validly created prior to 23 December 1996.

Our investigations have found that Section 24JA is available for all the Reserves in this report excepting:

- Speers Road Reserve (R.1001070).
- Moxham Park (R.83745).
- Pitt Row Headmasters Cottage Reserve (R.1014228).
- Old Kings Parade Ground (R.1031748).
- Marri Badoo Reserve (R.1040094).

B. <u>Likely Extinguishment of Native Title</u>

Parts or the whole of the following Reserves have been subject to acts that in my opinion may have extinguished Native Title² being:

- North Rocks Park (R.83210) in full with the Crown Grant to Richard Owen.
- North Rocks Senior Citizen Centre (R.91691) in full with the Crown Grant to Richard Owen.

² Only the Federal Court of Australia or higher court may make a determination of Native Title.

- Speers Road Reserve (R.1001070) in full with the Crown Grant to William Charles Wentworth.
- Marri Badoo Reserve (R.1040094) in full with the Crown Grant to James Elder.

C. <u>Other issues</u>

Our investigations have found other actions which Council may seek to correct.

 Request the Department of Planning and Environment – Crown Lands to undertake an update to the first schedule of Lot 1 DP 119247 being title for Mays Hill Reserve (NE) D.500640 from Trustees of the Congregational Union of NSW as is currently shown to The State of New South Wales and appoint Parramatta City Council as Crown Land Manager.

Native Title Managers Report

A. Proposed Act

This report considers the following relevant act:

• Adoption of the Parramatta City Council's Community and Crown Land Plan of Management (CCLPoM) provided by email on 26 September 2023, as it relates to Crown land managed by Council as Crown Land Manager under the *Crown Land Management Act 2016*.

B. Summary

The adoption of CCLPoM authorises further acts which will or may impact Native Title.

Future acts requiring further advice

However, the CCLPoM requires that prior to final individual approval some of those acts require further Native Title manager advice, being:

- the issuing of leases, licences and permits other than those listed in Section D(6) of this report.
- the construction of public work.

The CCLPoM also requires that prior to any public work or easement being approved the requirements of the *Native Title Act 1993*, and in particular to the notification and opportunity to comment requirements under Section 24JB or Section 24KA, are addressed.

Future acts not requiring further advice

Licences and other estates listed in Section D(6) of this report are valid future acts under Section 24JA of the *Native Title Act 1993*.

Other uses set out in the CCLPoM, are valid future acts under Section 24JA or Section 24LA of the *Native Title Act 1993* or do not impact Native Title.

In my opinion **Parramatta City Council's Community and Crown Land Plan of Management** provided to me 26 September 2023 **complies with the applicable provisions of the Native Title legislation**.

Should Native Title not prove to be extinguished by a prior act, any Native Title holders may be entitled to compensation for the act, in the event of a determination that Native Title exists in the land, and Council may be liable to indemnify the State in the payment of any compensation.

C. Basis of Advice

The subject land is Crown land under the *Crown Land Management Act 2016* (CLMA). This Crown land is listed in Table 1 showing the purpose the land is reserved for, the date of reservation, the legislation employed in the reservation process and Council's appointment information.

- 1. Following various legislative changes in the management of Crown land, and changes in the areas and names of local government authorities, Parramatta City Council is now Crown land manager of the Crown land listed in Table 1 for the purposes of the CLMA.
- 2. A search of the National Native Title Tribunal Registers on 27 September 2023 indicates:
 - no current Native Title claims in the Parramatta City Council local government area;
 - no Indigenous Land Use Agreements in the Parramatta City Council local government area; and
 - no Native Title determinations within the Parramatta City Council local government area.
- 3. We are not aware of any compulsory acquisitions of native title or future act protection determinations which would impact the land in Table 1.
- 4. We are not aware of the any Native Title certificates under the CLMA having been issued impacting Table 1.
- 5. For the purposes of Section 8.7(1) of the CLMA:
 - The land in Table 1 is *relevant land*,
 - none of the land in Table 1 is *excluded land*, and
 - Parramatta City Council is the *responsible person*.

There is a level of doubt regarding whether lands granted to various religious denominations continue to be Crown land dedicated for a particular purpose. The inclusion of the waiver of conditions etc from the Grants (as validation of grants) in the *Church of England Trust Property (Amendment) Act (No.2) 1923, Roman Catholic Church Trust Property Act, 1936 , The Presbyterian Church (New South Wales) Property Trust (Amendment) Act, 1956* and the *Baptist Union Incorporation (Amendment) Act 1958* might be considered to have voided the dedications or reserves. Lot 1 in DP 795277 (see next page) and possibly lot 7056 DP 1028195 (next page) fall into this category. Regardless, The Department of Planning, Industry and Environment continues to treat all land within the May's Hill Cemetery as being defined as a public cemetery under the *Local Government (Control of Cemeteries) Amendment Act 1966*. This includes cemetery land under a particular religious denomination. This Act provided for care control and management by Council and the subsequent 20 Aug 1993 gazette notice (see **Tag16D**) paved the way for Council's current Crown land manager appointment.

Lot 1 DP 119247 was granted to Samuel Goold, James Daubeny Brown and Moses Gazzard on Trust as a Burial Ground for Congregationalists. With the commencement of the *Congregational Union Incorporation Act 1882* the land transferred to the Trustees of the Congregational Union of New South Wales. Our investigations have not found evidence that grants to the Congregational or the Baptist Church had a subsequent waiver of conditions etc before the *Local Government (Control of Cemeteries) Amendment Act 1966.* In our opinion this land transferred to Council with the *Local Government (Control of Cemeteries) Amendment Act 1966.* In our opinion this land transferred to list Council would be able to lodge an application to Land Registry Services to have the title changed to list Council in the First Schedule. To our knowledge this has not been tested in a court of law.

- 2. The CCLPoM authorises the use set out in Table 2:
- 3. The CCLPoM authorises development:
 - consistent with the public purpose/s of the Crown reserve.
 - consistent with the land category assigned to the site under the CCLPoM and in accordance with the *Local Government Act 1993*.
 - generally consistent with Council's *Local Strategic Planning Statement* and the objectives of the applicable land use zone of the area under *Parramatta LEP 2023*.
 - generally consistent with the CCLPoM, and any other relevant plans, policies or strategies of Council.
 - consistent with SEPP (Transport and Infrastructure) 2021 or Division 1, Part 2 of SEPP (Exempt and Complying Development Codes) 2008.
 - for the maintenance upgrade and replacement of sewer and water infrastructure.
 - set out in Table 3.
 - consistent with any Native Title manager advice that complies with any applicable provisions of the Native Title legislation in accordance with Section 8.7 of the *Crown* Land Management Act 2016.
 - following consideration of any Aboriginal Land Claim that may apply to the land where the land is subject to a claim under the *Aboriginal Land Rights Act 1983* in order to not prevent the land from being transferred in the event the claim is granted.

 - the Lease, Licence or other estate is for a permitted purpose listed in Section 46 of the *Local Government Act 1993* and/or Part 4 Division 3 of the *Local Government Regulations 2005*.

E. Land Status

Table 1 shows the current reserve status of the land.

G. Further Native Title Manager Advice

Further Native Title manager advice will be required prior to issuing approval for future acts listed in D(3), D(4) and those in D(5) but not specified in D(6).

Any public works proposed will require that notification and opportunity to comment be given to NTSCORP Limited as the representative Aboriginal /Torres Strait Islander body and any registered Native Title claimant or holder.

H. Consequences

- (1) The acts are valid.
- (2) Apart from that noted in Section (G) any uses, developments and tenures authorised by the CCLPoM and not requiring further Native Title manger advice will either have no impact on Native Title or be valid under Section 24JA of the *Native Title Act 1993*.

See Section D of this report for this list of uses etc.

- (3) Where the proposed act is the establishment or construction of a public work, Native Title will be extinguished over the footprint and curtilage of the works. A public work is defined as:
 - (a) any of the following that is constructed or established by or on behalf of the Crown, or a local government body or other statutory authority of the Crown, in any of its capacities:
 - (i) a building, or other structure (including a memorial), that is a fixture; or
 - (ii) a road, railway or bridge; or
 - (iia) where the expression is used in or for the purposes of Division 2 or 2A of Part 2--a stock-route; or
 - (iii) a well, or bore, for obtaining water; or
 - (iv) any major earthworks; or
 - (b) a building that is constructed with the authority of the Crown, other than on a lease.

Major earthworks are defined as:

earthworks (other than in the course of mining) whose construction causes major disturbance to the land, or to the bed or subsoil under waters.

- (4) In the event of a future Native Title determination where Native Title is found to exist Native Title holders may be entitled to compensation. Compensation will be payable by the State. Council may be liable to indemnify the State for such compensation.
- (5) Under Subdivisions J and K of the future act provisions of the *Native Title Act 1993*, notification and the right to comment is required if the relevant act consists of the construction or establishment of a public work. The requirement will be satisfied when specific public works are proposed, and appropriate development plans are prepared. Notification is not required at this stage.

R.83210 North Rocks Park – Native Title

Crown Grant

The whole of R.83210 was previously part of a 30-Acre Crown Grant to Richard Owen on 12 March 1800 (see **Tag 2H** for Crown Grant & **Tag 2I** for extract of the historical parish map, Parish of Field of Mars, County of Cumberland, undated edition).

The Crown Grant to Richard Owen appears to be consistent with Section 23B(2)(c)(ii) of the *Native Title Act 1993* and it is my opinion that Native Title is likely to be extinguished over R.83210.

Our investigations have not found any other act likely to have extinguished Native Title over the remainder of R.83210. Please note, however, that no investigation has been undertaken into the extinguishment of Native Title via a public work under Section 23B(7) of the *Native Title Act 1993*.

R.91691 North Rocks Senior Citizen Centre – Native Title

Crown Grant

The whole of R.91691 was previously part of a 30-Acre Crown Grant to Richard Owen on 12 March 1800 (see **Tag 2H** for Crown Grant & **Tag 2I** for extract of the historical parish map, Parish of Field of Mars, County of Cumberland, undated edition).

The Crown Grant to Richard Owen appears to be consistent with Section 23B(2)(c)(ii) of the *Native Title Act 1993* and it is my opinion that Native Title is likely to be extinguished over R.91691.

Our investigations have not found any other act likely to have extinguished Native Title over the remainder of R.91691. Please note, however, that no investigation has been undertaken into the extinguishment of Native Title via a public work under Section 23B(7) of the *Native Title Act 1993*.

R.51125 Arrunga Gardens – Native Title

Our investigations have not found any prior act likely to have extinguished Native Title over R.51125.



R.1001070 Speers Road Reserve – Native Title

Crown Grant

The whole of R.1001070 was previously part of a 260-Acre Crown Grant to William Charles Wentworth on 29 October 1834 (**Tag 29F** for Crown Grant & **Tag 29G** for prior Volume-Folio 6225-165 to Alec Speers in fee simple title which included the land now within R.1001070 prior to subdivision creating Lots 142 & 172 DP 23173 and the land now within Lot 10 DP 1148832).

The Crown Grant to William Charles Wentworth appears to be consistent with Section 23B(2)(c)(ii) of the *Native Title Act 1993* and it is my opinion that Native Title is likely to be extinguished over R.1001070.

Our investigations have not found any other act likely to have extinguished Native Title over the remainder of R.1001070. Please note, however, that no investigation has been undertaken into the extinguishment of Native Title via a public work under Section 23B(7) of the *Native Title Act 1993*.

R.55439 Hammers Road Reserve – Native Title

Our investigations have not found any prior act likely to have extinguished Native Title over R.55439.

R.55445 Bell Bird Bend – Native Title

Our investigations have not found any prior act likely to have extinguished Native Title over R.55445.

R.83745 Moxham Park – Native Title

R.83745 was previously known as Portion 37. Part of Portion 37 was subject to the granting of various special leases prior to being placed under reserve, however these special leases were for the purpose of Quarry (see **Tag 36D** for Crown Plan 620-2030 & Crown Plan 845-690). A special lease Quarry is not a scheduled interest in Part 1 Schedule 1 of the *Native Title Act 1993* lease purpose and does not extinguish Native Title.

Our investigations have not found any other prior act likely to have extinguished Native Title over R.83745. Please note, however, that no investigation has been undertaken into the extinguishment of Native Title via a public work under Section 23B(7) of the *Native Title Act 1993*.

R.1014228 Pitt Row Headmasters Cottage Reserve – Native Title

Our investigations have not found any prior act likely to have extinguished Native Title over R.1014228.

R.1031748 Old Kings Parade Ground – Native Title

Our investigations have not found any prior act likely to have extinguished Native Title over R.1031748.

R.43291 Bundilla Forest – Native Title

Our investigations have not found any prior act likely to have extinguished Native Title over R.43291.

R.1040094 Mari Badoo Reserve – Native Title

Crown Grant

The whole of R.1040094 was previously part of Portion 85 subject to a 100-Acre Crown Grant to James Elder on 31 August 1833 (see **Tag 65E** for Crown Grant & **Tag 65F** for Crown Plan 244-690 for prior Portion 85).

The Crown Grant to James Elder appears to be consistent with Section 23B(2)(c)(ii) of the *Native Title Act 1993* and it is my opinion that Native Title is likely to be extinguished over R.1040094.

Special Lease

The whole of R.1040094 was also previously subject to Special Lease 1962-78 Metropolitan for "Erection of Buildings (Pre School Centre)" under the provisions of the *Crown Lands Consolidation Act 1913* to the Trustees of the Rydalmere Pre School Centre on 1 February 1963 (see **Tag 65G** for gazette notification).

The grant of the Special Lease 1962-78 Metropolitan to the Trustees of the Rydalmere Pre School Centre <u>may</u> also be consistent with Section 23B(2)(c)(i) and Schedule 1 Part 1(3)(8) of the *Native Title Act 1993*. Schedule 1 Part 1 (3)(8) provides for "Erection of Buildings" as a valid purpose under the Act. It is my opinion that Native title is also likely to be extinguished by this Special Lease over R.1040094.
