BACKGROUND

1. After more than 20 years in the role, Robert Love AM is stepping down as Director of Riverside Theatres.
2. Under his direction Riverside Theatres has become one of the most highly valued and respected theatres in the country, with its enviable performance, education and events programming, and foundation of the resident theatre company, National Theatre of Parramatta, putting theatre in Parramatta on the map.
3. Throughout his tenure, Robert has approached the role with an inspiring enthusiasm and passion, transforming Riverside Theatres into the institution it is today.
4. Robert has made invaluable contributions to Riverside Theatres and the performing arts industry and I congratulate him on his successes and efforts.
5. City of Parramatta Council is incredibly proud and grateful for the legacy he has built as a champion of the arts in Western Sydney, and for the contributions he has made to the Australian arts community for more than 45 years.

Since founding his own theatre company 'Toe Truck Theatre' in 1976, Robert Love has enjoyed an illustrious career in the performing arts world, working at the University of Sydney's Seymour Centre, State Theatre Company of South Australia, Sydney Theatre Company, Fox Studios and News Limited before commencing as Riverside Theatres Director in 2000. As a longstanding champion of the performing arts in Western Sydney, in 2017 he was made a Member (AM) in the General Division of the Order of Australia.

PURPOSE:

The purpose of this Lord Mayor Minute is to congratulate Walker Corporation on 3 & 4 Parramatta Square being awarded 6 Star Green Star ratings.

BACKGROUND

- 1. The 70,000 square metre 4 Parramatta Square is now the first and only building in Parramatta to achieve a 6 Star Green Star – Interiors rating as well as a 6 Star Green Star – Design & As Built rating, the highest rating possible under the Green Building Council of Australia's assessment framework.
- 2. The 17-level, 3 Parramatta Square delivering over 40,000 square metres of commercial space has also been awarded a 6 Star Green Star – Design & As Built rating.
- 3. Forming part of Australia's largest current urban renewal project, 3 and 4 Parramatta Square achieved the ratings through their energy efficiency, low emissions, strong public transport links, materials selection, technology and innovation.
