

Current status of the Quarterly Grants program

In the 2021/22 financial year the City of Parramatta Council Small Grants Fund is allocated \$40,000, Sport and Recreation Grants Fund allocated \$30,000 and the Representative Sport Grants Fund is allocated \$20,000. The first two funds have four application rounds. The Representative Sport Grants are open all year round and assessed immediately. This report provides the current status of these programs.
