

**Attachment 2 – List and description of proposed names for the unnamed laneway in Granville.**

Based on the research provided by Council’s archivists, the following five names are recommended for use.

Harmon Lane	<p>Acknowledging the Harmon family William Henry (c. 1853 - d. 11/05/1933, aged 80) who owned allotments 6 and 12 of Alfred Street (west side) backing on to the unnamed laneway from 1912, and 1894 respectively;</p> <p>Wife: Jessie Martha Harmon (nee Lovett) (b. c.1857- d. 18.11.1923;</p> <p>Children:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. William Richard ‘Lance’ Harmon (b. 1879 - );</li> <li>2. Fanny Pricilla Hamilton (nee Harmon) (b. 1880 - d. 20.07.1929);</li> <li>3. Walter Thomas Harmon (b. 1882 - );</li> <li>4. Oliver James Harmon (b. 1884, Redfern NSW – killed in action 6.08.1916, Battle of Pozieres, France);</li> <li>5. Arthur E Harmon;</li> <li>6. Grimwood owned land on either side of the unnamed lane (see NSW LRS HLRV vol fol. 947-65 and 1190-86).
