Bukbuk Walk	Meaning - Owl. <div><div>Road Name</div><div>Road Location</div><div>Proposal status</div><div>Bukbuk WalkEPPINGPre-Approved</div></div>
Garada Walk	Meaning - Laneways / short paths. <div><div>Road Name</div><div>Road Location</div><div>Proposal status</div><div>Garada WalkEPPINGPre-Approved</div></div>
Guman Walk	Meaning - Pine or Fir tree. <div><div>Road Name</div><div>Road Location</div><div>Proposal status</div><div>Guman WalkEPPINGPre-Approved</div></div>
Midiny Walk	Meaning - Yam (a sort of local wild potato) <div><div>Road Name</div><div>Road Location</div><div>Proposal status</div><div>Midiny WalkEPPINGPre-Approved</div></div>
